



Organizational Membership

What is an Organizational Membership?

Organizational Membership provides for a professional organization (such as a society, association or academy) with opportunity to participate in the ISMR as an organization.

What does Organizational Membership not provide?

Organizational Membership does not provide an individual member of an organization with any form of membership in the ISMR. Individuals wishing to hold membership in the ISMR must make application for constituent or student membership in the ISMR.

Applying for Organizational Membership

- A professional organization may apply for Organizational Membership in the ISMR on behalf of the Constituent Membership of that organization
- Application by an organization for Organizational Membership in the ISMR must be made by the Executive of that organization

Benefits of Organizational Membership

1. Cooperation between organizations dedicated to international promotion of the disciplines with an interest in reconstruction and rehabilitation of the head and neck. The definition of head and neck as it is used here is in the broadest sense.
2. Mutual recognition on the ISMR and Organizational Member's websites.
3. Potential to co-host conferences and workshops in collaboration with the ISMR
4. Publishing of Organizational Member announcements, news and photographs in the Organizational Member section of the ISMR Communications
5. Participation in the Advisory Council of Organizational Members (ACOM) of the ISMR
6. ISMR and Organizational Members mutually promote each other's organizations and activities:
 - On their respective websites.
 - By announcing conferences or other functions at each other organizations conferences.
 - By displaying brochures of the organization and its conferences or other functions at each other organizations conferences or meetings
7. ISMR and Organizational Members to work synergistically and strategically to support each other's organizations
